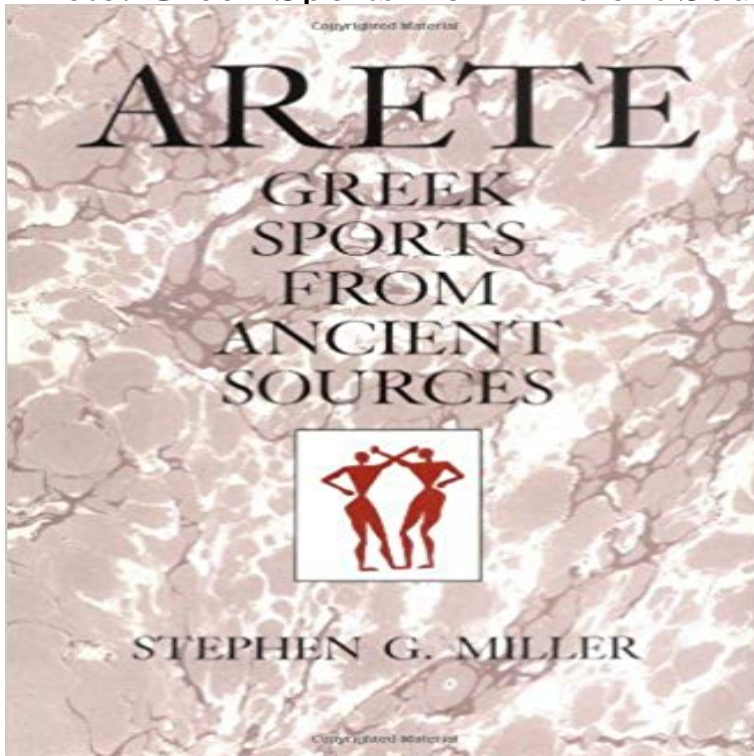


## Arete: Greek Sports from Ancient Sources
