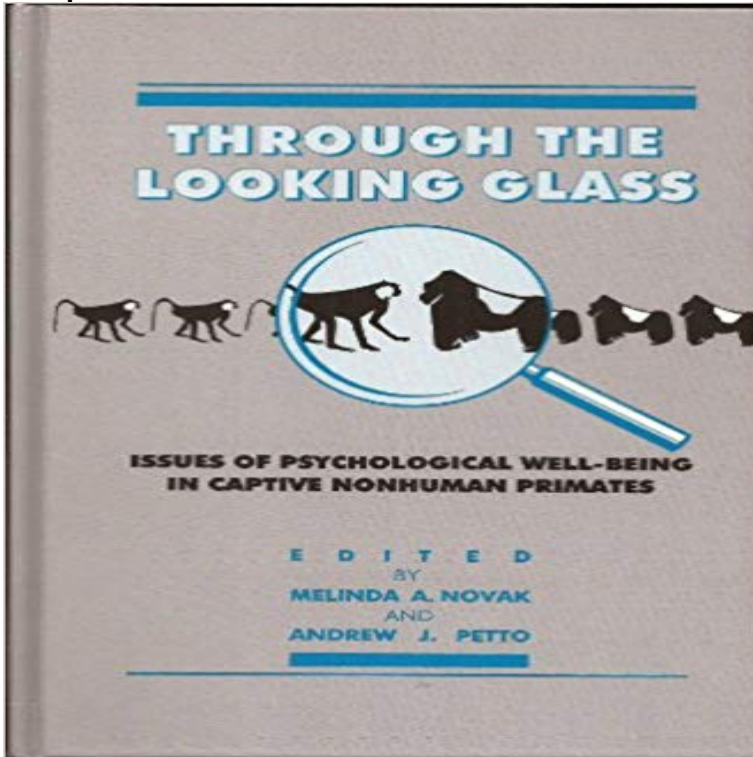


Through the Looking Glass: Issues of Psychological Well-Being in Captive Nonhuman Primates
